“ME AND MY PAL” DRAWING CONTEST 2018-2019

The “Me and My Pal” drawing contest was created by the Franklin County Auditor’s Office to help promote responsible pet care and ownership. One of the responsibilities of the Auditor is to license all dogs in the county. We licensed over **91,380** dogs last year. Licensing your dog is required by the State of Ohio. The license is an assigned I.D. number that identifies you as the owner should the dog get lost or separated from you.

CONTEST RULES:

1. Employees of the Franklin County Auditor’s Office, Franklin County Dog Shelter and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in the contest.
2. **All entries must be received by the participating public libraries or the Franklin County Auditor’s Office on Wednesday, November 28, 2018. (Please mail documents)**
3. Only one entry per owner or non-owner permitted.
4. The entry must be the drawing of the qualifying artist.
5. Qualifying artists are K-6 grade level students enrolled in a school within Franklin County, Ohio.
6. All dogs must be currently licensed and immunized.
7. The submitted drawing must include the artist and the dog(s).
8. There are two entry categories, dog owners and non-dog owners for each grade level.
9. There will be one winner from each category per grade level.
10. An overall contest winner will be selected from among the winners in the dog owner category.
11. A panel will be selected to judge the submitted entries.
12. The overall contest winner chosen from the dog owner category will receive the first dog tag issued for 2019, have their drawing featured in the 2019 dog licensing promotional flier distributed to locations throughout the county where dog licenses are sold and have their photo taken and posted to the Auditor’s social media sites.
13. The other six winners from the dog owner category will receive the next six dog tags issued for 2019, along with a picture taken and posted to the Auditor’s social media sites.
14. All winners will receive an award certificate and commemorative photo taken with the Auditor.
15. For drawings, please use 8.5 x 11 white bond paper, with pencil, pen, markers or paint.
16. All entries will become the property of the Franklin County Auditor.
17. Winners will be contacted by Friday, December 6, 2018.
18. The overall winner’s drawing will be used as a display at locations where dog licenses are sold throughout Franklin County Ohio.
19. A ceremony to celebrate and award the winners will be held Saturday, December 15, 2018 at 10AM at the Franklin County Dog Shelter located 4340 Tamarack Boulevard, Columbus, Ohio.

*** We ask that you delay purchasing or renewing a dog license until after the awards ceremony on December 15. In the event your submission is selected, a one year dog license will be awarded to your dog. If your entry was not among the 14 selected you will be notified no later than December 15.”**
