

Reminder: Property Tax and Tax Assistance Program Deadlines Extended

COLUMBUS, Ohio – Due to the current public health emergency, the deadline to pay the second half of property taxes to the Franklin County Treasurer's office has been extended from June 22 to Aug. 5.

Anyone with questions about their property tax bill, or who would like to submit a payment, can contact the Franklin County Treasurer's Office at 614-525-3438 or <u>Treasurer@franklincountyohio.gov</u>. In addition, the deadline for seniors to apply for the Property Tax Assistance Program (PTAP) has also been extended to July 5.

The PTAP provides emergency one-time property tax assistance to low-income homeowners age 60 or older, and is a nonprofit entity funded solely through donations. The Franklin County Auditor's office has administered the program since November.

PTAP applications are reviewed by a Board consisting of the Franklin County Auditor, Franklin County Treasurer, Franklin County Office on Aging, Central Ohio Area Agency on Aging, Concord Counseling, Clintonville CRC, Columbus Catholic Social Services, Syntero, and St. Stephens Community House.
